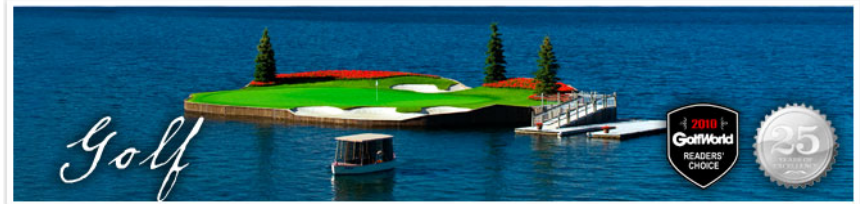

Coeur d'Alene Resort Golf Course

The Coeur d'Alene Resort Golf Course was the site of a sawmill, which operated from 1916 to 1988, first as the Rutledge Timber Company, and from 1933 as the Potlatch Lumber Company. It was shut down in the early 70's and sat idle until Mr. Hagadone (owner of the CDA Resort) purchased it. This Par 71 course is 6,803 yards in length. Designed by Scott Miller, the course encompasses 200 acres with lake view from all 18 holes. The floating green encompasses 15,000 Square Feet and weighs approximately 5,000,000 lbs. The average distance from the tee is 147 yards.
