This appendix offers an index designed to help users easily locate the three types of income and rent information provided in the RHIIP Case Study materials:

- a. Narrative text discussions**
- b. Pre-tests and Post-tests**
- c. Case studies**

The index is organized alphabetically by common topic or subject (e.g., **C**hild Care Expense/Deduction, **E**arned/Employment Income, **M**edical Expenses, etc.).

Under each topic there are three columns, as follows:

- Left Column: Text Discussion.

Key page references in the Participant Manual text that deal with the topic are listed (for example, “4-10” refers to page 4-10 in Module 4). The reference to the primary discussion of that topic is listed in **bold** type.

- Middle Column: Pre-test/Post-test Questions and Answers.

Tests are listed by the module in which they appear. The letter "Q" specifies the applicable question within the test (for example, “Q4” refers to Question 4 of the test). Numbers in parentheses indicate where the question and answer may be found (first number represents page number of original question / second number represents page number of the answer key).

- Right Column: Case Study Questions and Answers.

Case studies are listed by the module in which they appear. The letters "CS" precede the case study number (for example, “CS2” refers to Case Study 2 of the module).

Sometimes an entire case study addresses the topic, in which case the index will simply list the case study number.

Usually, however, only particular questions within a case study will apply to the topic. In this case, the index will include the letter "Q" followed by the applicable question number, to guide you to the appropriate question (for example, “CS2 Q2” refers to Question 2 of Case Study 2 of the module). Like the test question references, numbers in parentheses indicate where the question and answer may be found (first number represents page number of original question / second number represents page number of the answer key).
